The Chair presented his findings from the survey:

- Many of our graduates have found work

It seems that an important issue, is that some of our graduate work in the field of communication – which may be grounds for further development of our programme I n that area.

The Internship/Field Work gets good reviews and is also an item to be developed.

Other comments for the Board:

Only 28 percent perceived their studies to qualify them for their current job requirements.

The importance of foreign placement is problematic in the current global situation, where students has no or few possibilities to travel. The importance of travels furthers the project of including a study trip.

The importance of "interdisciplinary education" and visibility towards future employers was stressed.

It was recommended that the career event should be developed. Sissel and Anja will present a format for a more frequent event that involves a closer meeting with future employers.
