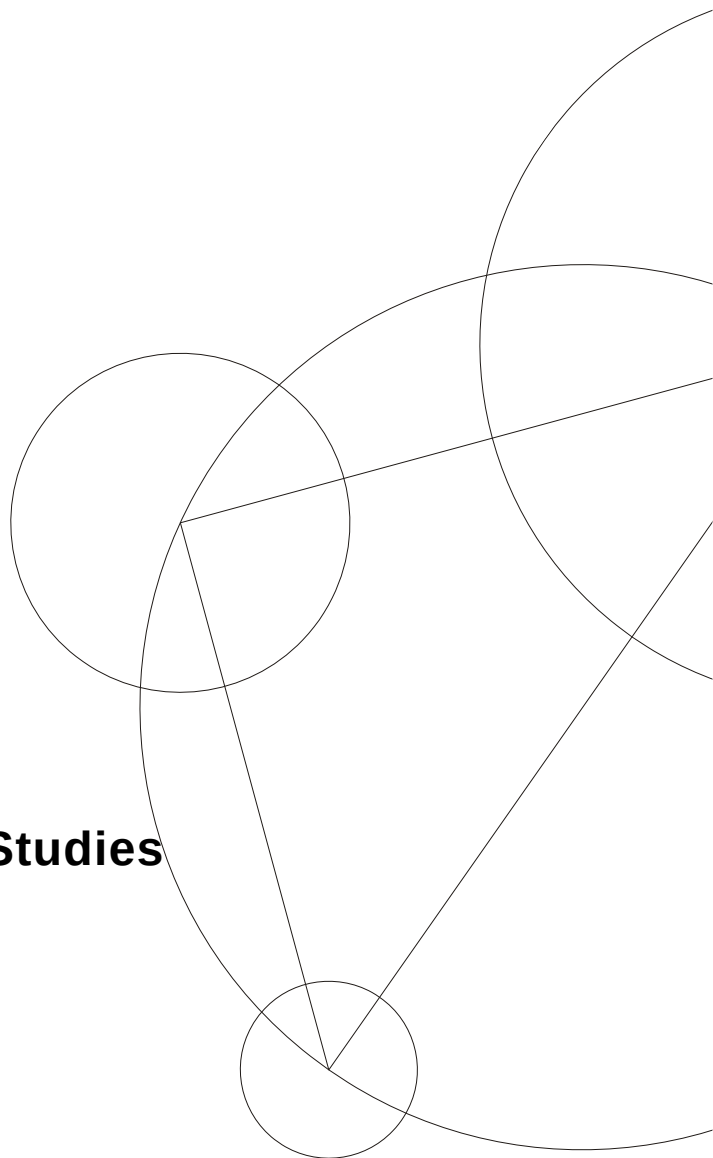

The list below consists of various scholarships for which students are entitled to apply. Some, such as the University of Copenhagen Internationalisation Scholarship, cover field work, internship placements and study periods abroad, whereas others are directed towards a specific subject.

Further information about various funding opportunities, including deadlines for applications, addresses, conditions, etc., is available in **Kraks legathåndbog (Kraks Handbook of Scholarships)**, which can be found in the International Office. The Students Online website (www.so.dk) allows you to conduct a detailed search of available scholarships. Remember also to keep an eye on *Universitetsavisen* (the University Paper) and the bulletin boards at the centre.

- **The University of Copenhagen's Internationalisation Scholarship**

Awarded to students at the University of Copenhagen, primarily from the third year onwards. Deadline for applications: around September/October. Application forms are available from the International Office, University of Copenhagen

- **The University of Copenhagen's Scholarships**

Different scholarships have different deadlines and application criteria, and applications are not permitted until they have been advertised.
