**Changes for Summer exams and re-exams 2021**

### MA PROGRAMME IN AFRICAN STUDIES

<b>Compulsory course: Advanced Research Methods</b>	No changes, we proceed with ordinary exam
<b>Compulsory course: Politics, Development and Change in Africa</b>	No changes, we proceed with ordinary exam
<b>Compulsory course: Religion, Culture and Society in Africa</b>	Oral online exam prepared on the basis of a selected exam question. A number of exam questions are defined and provided by the course lecturer seven days before the oral exam. The oral exam is 25 minutes long including assessment and will take place online in ZOOM.

<b>Thematic course: Religion, Popular Culture and the Media</b>	No changes, we proceed with ordinary exam
<b>Thematic course: Critical Development Planning and Policy</b>	No changes, we proceed with ordinary exam
<b>Thematic course: Governing Africa's natural resources</b>	No changes, we proceed with ordinary exam
<b>Language course: Kiswahili II</b>	The exam takes the form of an oral exam. It is 30 minutes long including assessment, with 30 minutes of preparation time and access to specified reference works. Both preparation and exam will take place online in ZOOM.
<b>Internship / Field Study</b>	No changes, we proceed with ordinary exam
<b>MA Thesis</b>	After the student submits the written thesis, a thesis defence takes place online in which the student presents the thesis and is examined by two examiners, namely the thesis supervisor and an external examiner. The oral thesis defence is 45 minutes long including assessment and will take place online in ZOOM.
<b>Professional Master final project</b>	The final project is assessed at an oral exam held a maximum of 2 months after the deadline for submission of the written assignment, July is not included. The exam is an individual 30-minute exam, including assessment and announcement of the result. No preparation time is allowed. The oral exam will take place online in ZOOM.
